

2022 DESTINATION CLIC IN-PERSON SESSIONS: VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Many non-essential activities in Canada, such as eating in restaurants, or attending sporting or sociocultural events require proof of vaccination. Each province decides which type of proof they accept, and for which situation. Currently, a Canadian COVID-19 proof of vaccination is required:

- for all plane or train travel within Canada
- to access non-essential services in some provinces or territories
- to participate in Explore or in Destination Clic in some institutions

Check with the host province to make sure you understand which proof is required. The following is the list of 2022 Explore institutions and their current vaccination requirements (required, not required). Please note the information may change as the COVID-19 situation evolves at the local, provincial/territorial, or pan-Canadian level.

DEFINITIONS

Required: The individual must be fully vaccinated to participate in the institution's in-person session. To qualify as fully vaccinated, the individual must have received at least two (2) doses of a Government of Canada-accepted of vaccination to pa session. Virtual sess vaccine.
