# WHAT COSTS ARE COVERED?

- ALL tuition fees, lodging, and meals
- Instructional materials
- Workshops and cultural activities

#### WHAT WILL IT COST ME?

- FREE to APPLY
- Registration fee (non-refundable; due on acceptance to the program)
- Travel to and from the program
- Optional cultural activities
- Personal spending money (for snacks or souvenirs, etc.)
- Other program-related fees may apply depending on the host institution

## WHERE WILL I STAY?

You will live on campus in a student residence to be close to the action and easily connect with Destination Clic peers.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Canadian citizens or permanent residents (those studying in Canada on a student visa are not eligible)
- Students must be enrolled in a French-language school (French as a first language)\*

\*Students who have French as a first language but do not attend a French-language school may also apply. Further documentation or a language assessment may be required to ensure that they have the required level of fluency to participate.
